

Auxiliary Emergency Fund Donation

The Auxiliary Emergency Fund is a national grant assistance program that provides temporary emergency assistance to eligible members of the American Legion Auxiliary up to \$3000 as the result of an act of nature or other personal crisis. Grant funds may be used only for shelter or utilities. Members of the American Legion Auxiliary whose dues are current and who have maintained membership for three consecutive years.
