We continue to work on the storage area to set-up for Veterans. We have shoes, some clothes, blankets, sleeping bags and more. Please only new items and not a lot.

We will be working closer with the **Veterans Woman Mental Health Clinic** and **LBCC**. LBCC has many

City College nursing programs. You may want to look into
a scholarship for Veterans!!!
