Unit 327 has something to cheer about; they get things done! If you want to make a poppy properly, come visit this unit. They meet once a week on a Wednesday at their club house or at a member's home at 9 am sharp. They will have 6-8 members a week and they get right to work with their poppy production.

Last year they made 31,000 poppies for their District 29 and Department of California. Communication with their department and district is so important. Proper poppy count helps with prompt distribution to all units. Storage for producing our poppies is a member's bedroom with all supplies and boxes to distribute. No, "she-shed" for these ladies! Taking poppies home and prepping for the next week can be tedious, but they do all they can to make this work.

This Unit stepped up to the plate when poppy production stopped at the VA Hospital in Long Beach in 2018. "Who was going to make the poppies?" Leisure World to the rescue, and they have been doing this ever since.

The average age of the seniors making poppies is in their 80s. Each year is a challenge for them with a passing of a member or health issues. Our members persevere by attending their meetings and making their poppies with pride. Our department cannot say enough to thank these ladies for their dedication.





DEC Information


The hotel for DEC is filing up. We are running low on rooms. If you haven't made your reservation and need a double room, please make your reservation asap.
